### Passport Fees due the <u>U.S. State Department</u>:

Adult passport book (age 16+) \$110.00

Child passport book (under age 16) \$80.00

\*Passport card (under 16) first-time applicants \$15.00

\*Passport card (age 16 +) first-time applicants \$30.00

**Expedited Fee** (faster) \$60.00

**Express Mail Fee** \$14.96

## Passport Fees due the <u>U.S. Postal Service</u>:

Processing Fee \$25.00

Photo Fee **\$15.00** 

OR bring two recent color photographs (2x2) inches in size

#### Items needed to process your passport application:





- Two recent color photographs (2x2) inches in size
- Additional documents depending on where you were born (see columns to right)

Born in the U.S.



- Bring proof of U.S. Citizenship (certified birth certificate, Previous U.S.Passport)
- Provide a Social Security Number



- Born outside the U.S.? Submit previous US Passport
  - Report of birth abroad
  - Certificate of Naturalization
  - Certificate of Citizenship

Passport card may not be used to travel by air! It will facilitate entry at U.S. land and sea ports-of-entry when arriving from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean and Bermuda
