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Brosnan Wins Grant from the Canadian Government

Associate Professor Kathleen Brosnan received a \$4,200 Faculty Research Grant from the Government of Canada to support the publication of an article comparing the history and effectiveness of the Niagara Greenbelt and the Napa Agricultural Preserve. Dr. Brosnan will conduct two months of research in Niagara consisting of archival work at Brock University, in St. Catharines, Ontario, Canada, and visits to nearby facilities to interview viticultural and tourism professionals. Her research is also part of a larger book project on the environmental history of Old World viticulture in the New World and the worldwide movements of vines, expertise, wine and cuisine.
