

Guest Speaker

Tom Herman was named Head Football Coach at the University of Houston on December 16, 2014 just one week after being named the 2014 Frank Broyles Award winner presented to the nation's top assistant football coach.

Herman has helped develop record-setting and explosive

offenses in each of his 10 seasons as an offensive coordinator, including his three seasons in the position of OC/quarterbacks coach at Ohio State University where he helped the Buckeyes win the 2015 College Football Championship with College Football Playoff wins over Alabama and Oregon, and the 2014 Big Ten Football Championship with a 59-0 win over Wisconsin.

Herman, who was named the 2013 Rivals.com Big Ten Recruiter of the Year and national Top 25 recruiter, arrived in Columbus after spending three years as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Iowa State University.

Herman is no stranger to the state of Texas and to Houston. Herman spent 2007 and 2008 as offensive coordinator at Rice University before heading to Iowa State. During his two seasons with the Owls, his offenses broke over 40 school records and in his second season the Owls won 10 games and went to a bowl for the first time since 1954. Rice ranked in the Top 10 nationally in 2008 in passing offense, scoring offense, and total offense. Two Rice receivers had more than 1,300 yards receiving that year. Rice tight end and former Houston Texans James Casey, had 111 catches and quarterback Chase Clement was the Conference USA MVP.

Prior to Rice, Herman directed offensive attacks for two years (2005-06) at Texas State, where Bobcat squads led the Southland Conference in total offense. The 2005 Texas State club was eighth nationally in scoring and made a run to the FCS semifinals in the school's first-ever appearance in the Division 1-AA playoffs. Herman also worked four years as an assistant coach at Sam Houston State, helping them to a pair of conference titles and trips to the FCS semifinals and quarterfinals.

Herman received Big 12 experience at Texas (1999-2000) serving as a graduate assistant with the offensive line on the Longhorns' Cotton and Holiday Bowl teams after receiving his coaching start in 1998 as a wide receivers coach at Texas Lutheran.

Herman was born in Cincinnati and still has family there. He was raised in Simi Valley, Calif., and he played collegiately at California Lutheran, in Thousand Oaks, graduating in 1997 with a degree in business administration. He received a master's in education from the University of Texas in 2000.

Herman and his wife, Michelle, have a daughter, Priya, and two sons, Maddock and Maverick.

THE HONORS COLLEGE

University Honors with Honors in Major

Students who complete the Honors College curriculum (36 hours) and complete a senior honors thesis.

University Honors

Students who complete the Honors College curriculum and elect not to complete a senior honors thesis.

Collegiate Honors and Collegiate Honors with Honors in Major

Students who fulfill the requirements for the honors program in the college of their major, including 21 hours of honors courses; who complete an Honors College minor, or who complete 21 hours of approved honors courses. If students also complete a senior honors thesis, they graduate with Collegiate Honors with Honors in Major.

Membership in The Honors College and Membership in The Honors College with Honors in Major

Students who affiliate with the Honors College during their undergraduates years and complete fewer than 21 hours of honors courses. If students also complete a senior honors thesis and fulfill the requirements of their major with distinction, they graduate with Membership in The Honors College with Honors in Major.

The College of Technology began in 1941 when local firms contributed funds for the third permanent building on campus for the new School of Technology. The first technical institute programs to be initiated by the new college in 1945 were also the first engineering technology programs in the state of Texas, accredited by the Engineers Council for Professional Development. By 1962, the College of Technology offered 16 programs-9 vocational and 7 engineering technology programs. By 1968, the college was granting a Bachelor of Science in Technology degree.

Throughout the decades, the School of Technology grew to meet the ever-changing disciplines associated with technology and the growing diversity of the student body. Today the college is comprised of four different departments and a wide range of disciplines.

The Construction Management department offers both an undergraduate and graduate degree in the field of Construction Management. The Engineering Technology department has carried forth the engineering technology programs that were the hallmark of the college's early years, and now covers the areas of biotechnology, computer engineering technology, electrical power engineering technology, and mechanical engineering technology. Students who affiliate with the Honors College during their undergraduates years and complete fewer than 21 hours of honors courses. If students also complete a senior honors thesis and fulfill the requirements of their major with distinction, they graduate with Membership in The Honors College with Honors in Major.
