Salutations and congratulations!

The past year has seen us reach many milestones in our journey together.

The 2017 class is the largest in the history of the Honors College, and with it we mark a number of firsts: the first

graduates of the Honors Biomedical Sciences Program, including those who are also completing their first year of medical school; the first graduates who have participated in the Bonner Leaders Program, a service learning cohort that has transformed the way we conceive a college education; the first graduates of the new Kathrine G. McGovern College of the Arts. To these firsts we proudly add that we are graduating not one but two regents of the University of Houston System!

Shortly after the historic milestone of March 2016, the installation of the University's Phi Beta Kappa Chapter, the Honors College was invited to compete with the best honors programs and colleges at the best universities in the country. We hoped to crack the top fifty and we put that metric in our strategic plan. Not only did we make the top fifty, UH Honors was rated among the top ten in the nation, one of only two programs so recognized in Texas. At this point, no one could blame you for thinking, "We are graduates of a Tier One, Phi Beta Kappa institution and a Top Ten Honors College . . . we have arrived!"

Tremendously important milestones, to be sure, and in January the University announced another: the billion dollar "Here, We Go" campaign to make UH even better. Honors graduates engage both classic and experiential learning opportunities, the great books and grand challenges activities that will benefit from the Honors College portion of the campaign. The great books of Human Sit are augmented with the experience of service locally with community partners such as New Hope Housing and service abroad in Honduras, Haiti, and India; with study away to Taos and Santa Fe, the Mississippi Delta, and Washington, DC, and with study abroad to Britain, Ireland, Greece, Rome, Israel, Russia, Peru, Ecuador, and the Galapagos Islands. Insights developed in the lecture hall and the seminar room are enhanced by informal but indispensable learning opportunities in the form of mentored research, reading groups after hours, dinners with profs, and trips to theaters and museums that bring the honors curriculum to life.

Such engagements have given you the margin of courage, confidence, and creativity to become leaders in your fields and in your communities. Ahead of you is a lifetime of success and giving back. You made it, you are here, and the journey continues. Here, We Go.
