#### **Jewish Family Service**

**Summer Transition Supported Employment Program -** The Summer Transition Supported Employment Program provides competitive volunteer/ work experience for participants, ages 16 – 26, with an Autism Spectrum Disorder and Mental Illness. JFS and Easter Seals Houston collaborate to in this 6 week program. The program is designed to help participants become more independent and successful in their communities and enhance their resumes. Participants will be matched with mentors who will accompany them to their workplace. **Date: June 19 - July 27**, Monday - Thursday, 9 am - noon or 1:30 pm - 4:30 pm - may choose 1 or both shifts. This program is **free** due to generous grant by the Hogg Foundation.

**Celebrating Transitions -** A 6 week program for students with cognitive disability, aged 15 -25, to help them prepare for their transition from school to work. They will be introduced to a variety of vocational experiences, including assembly, retail and culinary. **Date: June 12 - July 21**, Monday - Friday, 9 am - 3 pm, Cost: \$1,000.


