 - First week transactions were 19,748 compared to same week of 2019 yielded 24,815 transactions (75%), Starbucks switched to connect ordering which will allow you to still use your stars and points (12% increase in sales), New addition to the Student Centers is Asado Mexican Cuisine (270 daily transactions and 3% lower costs than Freshii)
 - Chick –Fil- A refresh will take place over winter break
 - Chartwells experiencing staffing shortage

- Project Updates
 - Most of the pavers are down

- More exterior power outside of South building
- The plaza stage cover is delayed due to foundation issues
- New carpet in the games room; will be adding a new section to amusement games area; will be adding gaming systems, screens and monitors for esports
- Secret Shopper Program (Chidera Ebisi)
 - Last semester launched the first Secret Shopper Program. Five questionnaires measured the Games room, Information Center, and CARS. Shoppers engaged staff by phone and through live chat interactions.
 - Surveys on Microsoft forms provided us with customer perspectives that will help us improve services
 - Results were analyzed, recommendations were made for improved training, data collection, scenarios development etc.
 - Will need assistance with program again this Fall

 - Blood drive held at Student Centers in partnership with Gulf Coast Regional Blood Center, received over 295 donors which saved over 1,000 lives
