A Lawrence Curry proposed a resolution that Undergraduate Council members of the UH, in a regular meeting assembly, "express their appreciation for the leadership and valuable contributions made to the university by Wilhelmina Cullen Robertson Smith during her long life and offer their condolences to her husband and family on the occasion of her death." Undergraduate members passed forth a motion to accept this resolution unanimously.

#### **B** Unification Process

Chair Larry Williams brought forth to Undergraduate Council members that President Khator would like to explore ways to strengthen ties between the campus councils and Faculty Senate. Ultimately, Dr. Khator would like to see a unified process in which communication among governance groups and Faculty Senate be improved. One of the proposals is to have the council chairs (UC, GPSC, Research Council, etc.) become members of the Faculty Senate Executive Committee. The main purpose is to have these chairs inform the Faculty Senate of current council business. Dr. Williams emphasized that the underlying council structure and meeting processes will not change and that the Faculty Senate will not become an additional reporting line of the councils. He also expressed that this proposal is one of many small steps in meeting President Khator's unification goal. Dr. Williams then invited the council members to ask questions and/or make comments.
