V Old Business

A Unification of Faculty Governance Proposal Framework (Bill Dupré and María Elena Soliño)

Unification of Faculty Governance meeting will be held this Monday. It has been proposed that the Undergraduate Council will become a subcommittee of the Faculty Senate. Clarification of whether all faculty Council members will become FS senators is needed. Council members appointed to the UC will not serve as senators. Simon Bott mentioned that an option for Council faculty members who want to serve on the Council, but not become a FS senator could be included in the unification proposal. Unification Task Force member Bill Dupré mentioned that faculty Council members couldn't run for both for council and an "at-large" FS positions. Faculty Senate EPSAC committee will merge into the Undergraduate Council. Overall, the day-to-day Council work will not change.

Simon Bott brought forth a few issues that the Council may consider as "deal breakers" in the unification proposal framework: elections years (academic year vs. calendar year), UC chair appointed by Faculty Senate rather than elected by the Council (Faculty Senate appoints their chairs), and membership transitioning into the unified Faculty Senate. Dr. Bott said that the Council needs to give their input on this matter: especially if they aren't amenable to this idea. He reiterated that the daily operations of the Council will not change. Only the Academic Policies & Procedures Committee will feel the change since they would have to report their recommendations on policies that affect the university as a whole to the Faculty Senate Executive Committee. However, beginning is January 2011, the unification project will begin to move forward and he expressed his desire for the Council to finalize their stance on this framework proposal via discussion during today's Council meeting. He proposed that a motion be made on each issue and voted on for inclusion into the framework to present to the Faculty Senate.

After much debating and discussion of each issue Simon Bott brought forth a motion for the Undergraduate Council to retain their chair election. The Council unanimously approved the retention of UC Chair election.

Council members felt that keeping the Undergraduate Council on an academic calendar year is better for logistics such as college elections, time needed for committee workload (college & Council), catalog updates, and CB reviews run smoother. To change to a calendar year would greatly affect Council (as well as college committee) operations. A motion was made to vote on retaining the academic year calendar. The retention of the Academic Calendar timeframe was unanimously approved.

Council members discussed the pros and cons of the UC transitioning into the Faculty Senate: should Council members immediately become FS senators or should they transition when their three-year term is up? A motion to bring in UC members as FS senators immediately was brought forth. The Council approved the immediate timing of membership transition with 3 nays and 2 abstentions.

Bill Dupré recommended a friendly amendment that the Council chair will be appointed based on the majority vote of the Undergraduate Council. The Council approved this amendment.

Lastly, a motion was made for the Undergraduate Council to accept the unification proposal to include the three "deal breakers" (chair election, academic calendar retention, and timing of membership transition). The Council voted in favor of this proposal with 2 nays.
