**D** UC member David Mazella is working on undergraduate course redesign project (student success initiative). He is welcoming course redesign ideas from UC members. Ideas are due by February 1st to Andrew Hamilton.

**E** Dr. Soliño informed the UC that she is an ex-officio representative on the University Commission on Women (UCW). She announced that this commission offers three awards: for a student, a staff employee, and a faculty member (pre-tenure and tenured). The nomination deadline is February 6, 2013. This is the second year that the University Commission on Women is offering these awards. Also, María Soliño has been asked by the UCW to gather comments/ideas regarding full time instructional faculty that have been incorporated into the Faculty Senate. She asked the UC to email their ideas to her.

### **III Administrative Reports**

#### **A Stephen Soutullo, Associate Vice President for Student Success and Access**

As of January 22, 2013, 38,349 students have enrolled. SCH is up by one percent.

#### **B Debbie Henry, Registrar, Registration and Academic Records**

The Office of Registration and Academic Records has forty one percent of degrees posted. Also there are 200 NR grades on record.

#### **C Agnes DeFranco, Associate Vice President for Undergraduate Studies**

Fall 2012 cohort has 95.3 percent retention. She thanked faculty for helping boost the numbers. Fall 2011 cohort was 94% retention.

#### **D Sal Loria, Executive Director, Scholarships & Financial Aid**

The Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid disbursed around \$100 million dollars of financial this week. SFA expects to disburse about \$150 million dollars of financial aid next week.

The online chat service is still a very popular help tool among students.

SFA is returning to annual evaluations and will stop mid-year evaluations. Federal laws are limiting the amount of financial aid to students. Therefore SFA policies/procedures will be undergoing changes and will become more stringent.
