## D Simon Bott, Teaching Excellence Awards Committee Chair

## III Administration Representatives' Reports

#### A Djuana Young, Office of Admissions

Over 1200 students had registered orientation. June 1<sup>st</sup> is the final application deadline for transfer students. April 1<sup>st</sup> is the application deadline for freshmen. The Office of Admissions' goal is to enroll 3500 freshmen and 3500 transfer students. April 18<sup>th</sup> is orientation for honors students.

## B Debbie Henry, Office of Registration and Academic Records

The myUH Wait List functionality was demonstrated to the colleges. Deans will decide the deadline to turn off the feature so that students will not be able to add themselves to the wait list. Dr. Bott was able to pilot the wait list for spring 2014 and informed the UC about his experience.

Registration begins next week (enrollment by appointment and open enrollment).

## C Teri Longacre, Division of Academic Affairs

The UH in Four website is in development. Her office is also collaborating with University Marketing on promotional items. Teri Longacre and her team will begin attending New Student Orientations to inform freshmen about the UH in Four program.

Dr. Croft introduced herself and explained her role in Academic Affairs to the Committee.

### VI Dean John Roberts, College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences

Dean Roberts informed the Committee that the College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences has collaborated with Academic Affairs to create the Provost summer reading program. Incoming freshmen read a common book over the summer and participate in activities (i.e., discussion seminar). "Stepping Out on Nothing" by Brian Pitts was chosen as UH's common book for 2014-

2015. Students will receive the book during orientation (books are free for students & faculty). The Sunday before fall classes begin, these students will participate in a seminar to discuss the book. Also the author of the book will visit the campus. This program will offer students activities such as essay contests. Dr. Roberts encouraged faculty from all over the campus (not just from CLASS) to volunteer. He asked the UC to encourage colleagues to volunteer in this program.
