IV Administrative Reports

A Debbie Henry, Registration and Academic Records

The Fall 2013-Summer 2014 Undergraduate Catalog was published this morning. The 2013-2014 Graduate Catalog is forthcoming.

RAR will be contacting college deans for Curriculog approvers. The Curriculog automated workflow project is moving forward. Key UH staff will be meeting with the consultants soon.

Amy Ramirez is the new program manager for the catalog and curriculum management systems.

B Steve Soutullo, Enrollment Services

Freshman class quality is better. Average SAT score is 1139 and class rank is up. The average GPA for transfer students is 3.03. Overall, enrollment is 39612 (down by 3%). ORD is September 11 and enrollment service numbers will be more accurate by then.

C Andrew Startz, Student Financial Services

Student Financial Services is currently running enrollment cancellations. However, the Welcome Center staff is working hard at making sure students are making payments.

D Diana Velez, Undergraduate Scholars

The new TSI is running smoothly.

E Teri Longacre, Interim Vice Provost and Dean for Undergraduate Student Success

Teri informed the Committee of the different student success initiatives her office is working on.

UH was selected to participate in the Foundations of Excellence study (John Gardner Institute for Excellence). This initiative focuses on the quality of the first year experience of a student. More information regarding the Foundation of Excellence and the John Gardner Institute can be found at www.jngi.org.

UH in Four: Focuses on four year graduation. Teri is collaborating with key staff and faculty on developing tools for students to plan better. She would like the Student Success subcommittee to help in the creation of a uniform format for degree plans. Also the subcommittee will need to look at academic policies that may hinder student progress and frequency of course availability.

Martha Dunkelberger suggested that transfer students should be included in student retention/persistence initiatives. She also asked the UC faculty members if they have had any issues with classroom scheduling which also affects student success.

David Mazella inquired if an advisor piece will part of the initiative? Teri Longacre said she has been collaborating with associate deans and advisors. She would like to the see advisor tools (DPR, academic planners, etc.) utilized on a regular basis.

These initiatives will require a culture shift in changing students' expectations.

Jennifer Wingard asked if there will be an initiative on helping students choose a major. Teri said they will be developing tools to move students into "best fit" majors. Professor Wingard also inquired about initiatives on how to transition an academic major into a career. Teri had referred her to Dan Maxwell since career services falls under the Student Affairs division.
