Office of Admissions Undergraduate Committee Report October 20, 2015

Spring 2016 Admissions

- Target enrollment goal is 2,000-2,300 with 80-100 freshman.
- Application deadline is December 18th and the credentials deadline is January 6th.
- The New Student Orientation (NSO) registration site opened on October 14th. 272 students have already RSVP to attend.
- Currently students are able to sign up to attend NSO on December 9th, 11th or January 8th. The remaining January conferences will open after December 12th.

Application and Admit Numbers

Transfer

2,237 transfer applications have been received. Applications are down 11.8% from 2015. 873 transfer students have been admitted. Admits are down 14.7% from 2015.

Freshman

353 freshman applications have been received. Applications are down 27.4% from 2015. 52 freshmen have been admitted. Admits are down by 14.7% from 2015.

Former Students

442 former student applications have been received. Applications are down 6.8% from 2015. 115 former students have been admitted. Admits are up by 16.2% from 2015.

Fall 2016 Admissions

Freshman

5,887 freshman applications have been received. Applications are up 18.9% from 2015. 947 freshmen have been admitted. Admits are up by 47.7% from 2015.

The Transfer and Former Student Application will open on January 2, 2016.

Cougar Preview – University Open House was held on October 17th. There were approximately 1,100 guests (600 students) in attendance.

Program Changes

- 1. Changes to <u>Atmospheric Science Minor</u> Because the list of previous list of 4 elective courses was too limiting and thus delayed graduation, the program proposes to replace the previous list with this requirement with a requirement for "six semester hours of approved advanced electives" which will allow for flexibility to add new courses as the program expands.
- 2. Changes to <u>Earth Science BA degree</u> Students will be required to complete Math 1431 and 1432 (Calculus I and II) in place of Math 1310 and 1330. This better prepares students mathematically for the major.
- 3. Changes to <u>Geophysics BS degree</u> This proposal increases the number of required geophysics courses and increases the number of geophysics elective courses that are offered. The degree requires 120 SCH.

The Degree Programs/Curriculog 1 Subcommittee met on October 21, 2015. The committee met in 112P Farish Hall. Subcommittee members present were Andrea Burridge, Teresa Chapman, Albert Flavier, Michelle Ivey, Susan Miertschin, Len Trombetta. Guests attending included Edward Blair and Michael Murray (both from Bauer College of Business).

Program Changes

The subcommittee recommends approval of the following program changes:

1. Changes to Environmental Sciences BS degree

- a. Addition of courses to Group 1 electives necessary to allow students to graduate in 4 years as most Group 1 courses are taught every other year. The statement "approved electives" is added as well.
- b. The recommended semester of completion is changed to ensure students complete elective requirements (Group 1 and Group 2) within 4 years.

2. Change to Business Entrepreneurship Major

a. Add 3 credit hours of a Values and Leadership course (a one credit hour course that will be repeated over three semesters). The number of required advanced electives is reduced to 3 from 6 SCH.

3. Changes to the **Supply Change Management Certificates**

Students must complete the courses that comprise the certificates with an average grade of B or better. In addition, the ability to make an approved course substitute is explicitly stated.

Program Policy Changes in Psychological, Health, and Learning Sciences:

The Department of Psychology, Health, and Learning Sciences is revising the readmission from suspension requirement and the admission to the HDFS-EC 6 certification program.

These changes ensure that (1) students admitted to the HDFS-EC-6 program meet State Board of Educator criteria for becoming teachers; and (2) create procedures to assist readmission students in progressing to degree completion.

To further strengthen the computational components of the undergraduate curriculum in Mathematics, the Department of Mathematics is introducing the following two new courses:

- 1. MATH 2131 Linear Algebra Labs with MATLAB, a one-unit course required for math majors, whose purpose is to introduce the usage of MATLAB to enhance understanding of concepts and applications of Linear Algebra.
- **2.** MATH 4366 Numerical Linear Algebra, a 4000-level Math elective course that can be combined with MATH4364 Introduction to Numerical Analysis in Scientific Computing to forms a new Math Senior Sequence for math majors.
