 - i. Addendum to October 28 Minutes: Discussion of Good Academic Standing
 - 1. Curriculog 1, Curriculog 2, and APP subcommittee have all been recently involved in a conversation regarding the definition of "good academic standing", revised language proposed by the College of Business for some pre-requisite requirements
 - 2. This revision in language is intended to address issue of incoming transfer students, coming in with a GPA of "0", being unable to enroll in courses with a pre-req GPA of 2.0.
 - 3. Concern over defining "good academic standing" by PeopleSoft standing; Catalog needs to make it clear, in a policy, what "good academic standing" means on a university level (with a college/department caveat)
 - 4. Dr. Dunkelberger asked the Catalog Subcommittee to look into this issue further, with the help of APP and Curriculog subcommittees, as well as Heidi Kennedy
